Proposed law prohibits raffling or giving away any animal as a novelty or prize at a carnival or fair.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines the term "animal" as chickens, ducks, iguanas, pot bellied pigs, rabbits, reptiles, fish, birds, and turtles.

<u>Proposed law</u> exempts a humane society, animal shelter, or a pet shop from caring for, adopting, or selling animals as pets from the provisions of <u>proposed law</u>.

Proposed law exempts hunting clubs that raffle hunting dogs from the provisions of proposed law.

<u>Proposed law</u> subjects any person, firm, or corporation convicted in a court of competent jurisdiction of violating the provisions of <u>proposed law</u> to a fine of not more than \$100 per violation. Each day on which a violation occurs constitutes a separate offense.
