<u>Proposed law</u> requires that by October 1, 2018, the dugout area of any baseball or softball field that is used for high school interscholastic athletics by any public school or nonpublic school that receives public funds be enclosed and designed in a manner to keep batted or thrown balls from entering the dugout unimpeded.

Proposed law provides the Act shall be known as the "Angelle Trahan Act".

Effective August 1, 2018.

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Education to the original bill

- 1. Provides that the dugout areas must be enclosed by no later than October 1, 2018.

Senate Floor Amendments to engrossed bill

1. Requires the enclosure to be designed to prevent a batted or thrown ball from entering the dugout unimpeded.
