- On page 6, between lines 12 and 13, enter the following:
 - "G. Members of the commission are eligible for reappointment by the appointing authority. Any vacancy on the commission shall be filled for the remaining portion of the term in the same manner as the original appointment.
 - (1) No member of the board of commissioners, whether appointed by recommendation of the nominating committee or the medical staff, shall serve more than three consecutive terms.
 - (2) In the case of an appointee named to fill the term of a member who has left the board and less than two years remain in the term, that term shall not be considered one of the two three consecutive terms to which a member is limited.
 - (3) In the case of an appointee named to fill the term of a member who has left the board and more than two years remain in the term, that term shall be considered one of the two three consecutive terms to which a member is limited.
