6 On page 3, at the end of line 26, delete "and" and on line 27 delete "a member of its Health

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 4, line 27, change "city" to "corporate"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 5

11 On page 5, lines 7, 8, and 9, change "July" to "January"

12 AMENDMENT NO. 6

13 On page 6, between lines 12 and 13, enter the following:

14 "G. Members of the commission are eligible for reappointment by the
15 appointing authority. Any vacancy on the commission shall be filled for the
16 remaining portion of the term in the same manner as the original appointment.

17 (1) No member of the board of commissioners, **whether appointed by**
18 **recommendation of the nominating committee or the medical staff,** shall serve
19 more than three consecutive terms.

20 (2) In the case of an appointee named to fill the term of a member who has
21 left the board and less than two years remain in the term, that term shall not be
22 considered one of the ~~two~~ **three** consecutive terms to which a member is limited.

23 (3) In the case of an appointee named to fill the term of a member who has
24 left the board and more than two years remain in the term, that term shall be
25 considered one of the ~~two~~ **three** consecutive terms to which a member is limited.
