COURTS/COMMISSIONERS: Provides relative to the salary of the commissioner of the Twenty-Second Judicial District Court

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 13:722(B), relative to the salary of the commissioner of Twenty-
3 Second Judicial District Court; to amend the amount of the maximum allowable
4 salary of the commissioner; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 13:722(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §722. Commissioners: qualifications; salary and benefits; restrictions on
8 employment; office space; supplies; equipment; employees

9 * * *

10 B. The salary of the commissioner shall be set by a majority of the elected
11 judges of the Twenty-Second Judicial District Court and shall not exceed ~~seventy-~~
12 ~~two thousand five hundred dollars~~ seventy-five percent of the total salary from all
13 sources paid to a district court judge of the Twenty-Second Judicial District Court
14 per annum. A commissioner may be a member of the Parochial Employees'
15 Retirement System. A commissioner may be reimbursed for his expenses as
16 provided for by court rule.

Abstract: Changes the 22nd JDC commissioner's salary to a percentage of the total salary from all sources paid to district court judges of the 22nd JDC.

Present law requires the judges of the 22nd JDC to set the salary of the commissioner which shall not exceed \$72,500 per year.

Proposed law amends the maximum allowable annual salary of the commissioner from \$72,500 to a sum not to exceed 75% of the total salary from all sources paid to district court judges of the 22nd JDC.
