R.S. 35:416 is hereby enacted to read as follows: 8 §416. Ex officio notaries for coroners 9 A. Notwithstanding any provisions of the law relative to qualifications for 10 notaries public, each coroner may designate one deputy or assistant per shift for each 11 office location and appoint them as ex officio notaries public. 12 B.(1) The deputy or assistant so appointed may exercise, in the parish which the coroner serves, the functions of a notary public only to administer oaths and 13 14 execute affidavits, acknowledgments, and other documents, all limited to matters 15 within the official functions of the office of coroner. For each such action, the notary 16 shall use the official seal of that respective coroner's office. 17 (2) He shall fulfill the same bond requirements as provided by law for 18 notaries in the parish which the coroner serves. 19 (3) The coroner shall pay as an expense of his office the costs of the notarial 20 seal, the notarial bond, and any fees required for filing the bond.

D. The coroner may suspend or terminate an appointment made pursuant to

Abstract: Authorizes coroners to appoint a deputy coroner or an assistant within their respective offices as ex officio notaries public.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes each coroner to designate one deputy or assistant per shift for each office location and appoint them as ex officio notaries public.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that each deputy or assistant so appointed may exercise, in the parish which the coroner serves, certain functions of a notary public limited to matters within the official functions of the office of coroner.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides procedures for the use of the official seal, requires the posting of bond, and prohibits compensation for the notarial services.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes the coroner to suspend or terminate an appointment, and provides that separation from employment shall automatically terminate the powers of the ex officio notary public.
