### DISTRICTS/NEIGHBORHOOD: Provides relative to the Lake Bullard Neighborhood Improvement District in Orleans Parish

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 33:9080(F)(1) and (3), relative to the Lake Bullard		
3	Neighborhood Improvement District in Orleans Parish; to provide relative to the		
4	parcel fee levied within the district; to provide relative to the amount, expiration and		
5	renewal of the fee; and to provide for related matters.		
6	Notice of intention to introduce this Act has been published		
7	as provided by Article III, Section 13 of the Constitution of		
8	Louisiana.		
9	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:		
10	Section 1. R.S. 33:9080(F)(1) and (3) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as		
11	follows:		
12	§9080. Lake Bullard Neighborhood Improvement District		
13	* * *		
14	F. Parcel fee. The governing authority of the city of New Orleans is hereby		
15	authorized to impose and collect a parcel fee within the district subject to and in		
16	accordance with the provisions of this Subsection:		
17	(1) The amount of the fee shall be as requested by duly adopted resolution		
18	of the board. The fee shall be a flat fee per improved parcel of land not to exceed		
19	two three hundred fifty dollars per year for each improved parcel.

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CODING: Words in struck through type are deletions from existing law; words <u>underscored</u> are additions.

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(3)(a) The fee shall be imposed only after the question of its imposition has been approved by a majority of the registered voters of the district who vote on the proposition at an election held for that purpose in accordance with the Louisiana Election Code. The amount of the fee may be changed by duly adopted resolution of the board, not to exceed the maximum amount authorized as provided in this Subsection. No other election shall be required except as provided by this Paragraph.

(b) The initial election on the question of the imposition of the fee shall be held at the same time as a regularly scheduled election in the city of New Orleans.

10 (c)(b) If approved, the fee shall expire on December 31, 2014 at the end of 11 the term provided for in the proposition authorizing the fee, not to exceed eight 12 years, but the fee may be renewed if approved by a majority of the registered voters 13 of the district voting on the proposition at an election as provided in Subparagraph 14 (a) of this Paragraph. Any election to authorize the renewal of the fee shall be held 15 only at the same time as the mayoral primary election for a regularly scheduled 16 election in the city of New Orleans. If the fee is renewed, the term of the imposition 17 of the fee shall be as provided in the proposition authorizing such renewal, not to 18 exceed eight years.

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20 Section 2. The provisions of this Act shall not affect the parcel fee being levied 21 within the Lake Bullard Neighborhood Improvement District on the effective date of this 22 Act, the "current fee". The governing authority of the city of New Orleans shall continue 23 to levy the current fee until such time as it expires, as provided in the proposition approved 24 by a majority of the district's registered voters voting on the proposition at an election held 25 on February 1, 2014. After expiration of the current fee, the governing authority of the city 26 shall then begin to levy a parcel fee as provided in this Act, if the parcel fee has been 27 approved by a majority of the district's registered voters as provided in this Act.

Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature

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- 1 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
- 2 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
- 3 effective on the day following such approval.

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Abstract: Provides relative to the parcel fee levied within the Lake Bullard Neighborhood Improvement District in Orleans Parish.

<u>Present law</u> creates the Lake Bullard Neighborhood Improvement District in Orleans Parish as a political subdivision for the purpose of promoting and encouraging the beautification, security, and overall betterment of the district.

### Proposed law retains present law.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the governing authority of the city of New Orleans, subject to voter approval, to impose a parcel fee on behalf of the district. Provides that the fee is a flat fee per improved parcel of land not to exceed \$250 per improved parcel per year. <u>Proposed law</u> increases the maximum rate of the fee from \$250 to \$350 per improved parcel per year.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the fee shall expire on Dec. 31, 2014, but authorizes renewal of the fee, subject to voter approval. Requires the election for renewal of the fee to be held only at the same time as the mayoral primary election for the city of New Orleans.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the fee shall expire at the end of the term provided for in the proposition authorizing the fee, not to exceed eight years. Requires the election for renewal to be held at the same time as a regularly scheduled election in the city of New Orleans.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the provisions of the Act have no effect on the parcel fee being imposed within the Lake Bullard Neighborhood Improvement District on the effective date of the Act. Provides that the fee shall continue to be imposed until it expires after which the fee authorized by <u>proposed law</u> may be levied.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
