HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

2018 Regular Session

Amendments proposed by Representative Hunter to Engrossed House Bill No. 633 by Representative Hunter

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 3, delete "water systems;" and insert in lieu thereof "facilities;"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 2, line 3, after "all" delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu thereof "water
5 supplies accessible by the public in all state-owned, state-operated, or state-licensed
6 facilities."

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 2, delete lines 4 and 5 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

9 "C. The office of public health shall perform random testing, or assist in the
10 performance of such testing, on a schedule determined by the office and subject to
11 appropriation of sufficient funds, for elevated levels of lead in water supplies of
12 elementary and secondary schools.

13 D. Any of the following sources of funding may be utilized solely or in
14 combination for implementation of the water testing requirements provided in this
15 Section:

16 (1) Fees remitted to the Louisiana Department of Health pursuant to R.S.
17 40:31.33.

18 (2) Proceeds received by the state pursuant to the provisions of R.S. 27:270,
19 as amended by the Act that originated as House Bill No. 553 of the 2018 Regular
20 Session of the Legislature.

21 (3) Any funding for water testing derived from any local, state, or federal
22 source."
