MTR VEHICLE/REGISTRATION: Creates a penalty for the registration of certain motor vehicles

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 47:462(D), relative to motor vehicle registration class; to establish a penalty
3 for the use of a registered motor vehicle for purposes other than those authorized in
4 the registration class; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 47:462(D) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

7 §462. Trucks and trailers

8 * * *

9 D. Any person or entity having obtained a Class 2, 3, 4, or 5 registration that
10 is found, by either local law enforcement or the Department of Public Safety and
11 Corrections, to be utilizing a registered vehicle for purposes other than those
12 consistent with the registration class shall be fined two thousand five hundred
13 dollars.

Abstract: Establishes a penalty for any person or entity that utilizes a registered vehicle for purposes other than those specified in the registration class.

Present law establishes classifications for the registration and licensing of trucks, tandem trucks, truck-tractors, semitrailers, and trailers.

Proposed law requires that any person or entity that has obtained a Class 2, 3, 4, or 5 registration and is found by local law enforcement or the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections to be utilizing a registered vehicle for purposes other than those consistent with the registration class be fined \$2,500.
