BY SENATOR WHITE

PUBLIC LANDS. Authorizes the secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development to transfer certain state property in Tangipahoa Parish. (8/1/18)

1 AN ACT

2 To authorize and provide for the transfer of certain state property; to authorize the transfer  
3 of certain state property in Tangipahoa Parish; to provide for the property  
4 description; to provide terms and conditions; and to provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 **Section 1. The secretary of the Department of Transportation and**  
7 **Development, notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, is hereby**  
8 **authorized and empowered to convey, transfer, assign, lease, or deliver any interest,**  
9 **the state may have to all or any portion of the following described parcel of property**  
10 **to Virgil Allen:**

11 **Lots 1 and 2, Block B, Jones Island Realty Co. Subdivision in Section 4,**  
12 **Township 9 South, Range 8 East, G.L.D., Parish of Tangipahoa, Louisiana.**

13 **Section 2. The secretary of the Department of Transportation and Development**  
14 **is hereby authorized to enter into such agreements, covenants, conditions, and**  
15 **stipulations and to execute such documents as necessary to properly effectuate any**  
16 **conveyance, transfer, assignment, lease, or delivery of title to the property described**  
17 **in Section 1, and as more specifically described in any such agreements entered into**

1 **and documents executed by and between the secretary of the Department of**  
2 **Transportation and Development and Virgil Allen.**
