Proposed law amends the criminal penalties for the crime of illegally supplying a felon with a firearm by adding "with or without hard labor" as part of the imprisonment terms.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

Proposed law may result in an indeterminable increase in SGF expenditures in the Department of Public Safety and Corrections - Correction Services (DPSC). Proposed law adds "with or without hard labor" to the crime of illegally supplying a felon with a firearm as part of the imprisonment terms. Present law provides for a maximum imprisonment term of five years. To the extent defendants are convicted with hard labor, it will result in an indeterminable increase in SGF expenditures to DPSC. The exact number of defendants the courts may convict and sentence "with hard labor" cannot be projected; therefore, the exact fiscal impact cannot be determined. To the extent the court convicts a person with hard labor SGF expenditures will increase by \$54.21 per offender per day if an offender is housed in a state facility or \$24.39 for a state offender housed in a local facility. An offender sentenced to the custody of the DPSC for one year would increase SGF expenditures by \$19,786.65 (\$54.21 per day x 365 days) if housed in a state facility and \$8,902.35 (\$24.39 per day x 365 days) if housed in a local facility. Approximately 50% of state offenders are housed in state facilities and approximately 50% of state offenders are housed in local facilities.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
