
SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs to
Original Senate Bill No. 445 by Senator Hewitt

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "To" delete the remainder of the line and on line 3, delete "and (B),
3 and 2179, and to"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 5, after "government;" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 6 and
6 insert "to provide for automatic elimination of certain reports; to require notification before
7 the automatic elimination; to provide for extension of reports scheduled for elimination; to"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, line 13, change "**B**" to "**C**"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, between lines 16 and 17, insert:

12 **"B. Except as provided in Subsection C of this Section, a legislative**
13 **mandate to produce any report required of an executive branch agency first**
14 **occurring on or before June 30, 2018, shall expire on the July first following**
15 **June 30, 2019, in the earliest year that is a multiple of five years after the**
16 **mandate was initially approved by the legislature."**

17 AMENDMENT NO. 5

18 On page 1, line 17, change "**B**" to "**C**"

19 AMENDMENT NO. 6

20 On page 2, delete lines 4 through 29 and delete pages 3 through 6, and on page 7, delete lines
21 1 through 6 and insert:

22 **"D. The executive branch agency tasked with producing the report shall,**
23 **not later than the January first immediately preceding the expiration date,**
24 **notify the committees of the pending expiration of the report via electronic mail.**
25 **The notification shall include at a minimum a citation of the original mandate**
26 **requiring the report, a copy of the most recent report, and an estimate of the**
27 **agency resources including costs expended in producing the report."**

28 AMENDMENT NO. 7

29 On page 7, line 7, change "Section 6" to "Section 2"
