Abstract: Provides for examination and licensing fees assessed by the Louisiana State Board of Cosmetology.

<u>Present law</u> provided an extensive list of fees for examinations, applications, and renewals for registered cosmetologists, estheticians, manicurists, and teachers. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> regarding the fees but pares down the specificity of each, combining classifications and raising the fees in certain instances.

Proposed law provides that the fees are nonrefundable.

<u>Present law</u> provides that an inspector may issue a citation and collect a fine of \$25 per violation of law up to \$300 per week. <u>Proposed law</u> changes <u>present law</u> to raise the fines to \$35 per violation up to a total of \$350 per week and further provides that in addition to fines being assessed for violations of law, that they may also be assessed for violation of a rule promulgated by the board.
