5	WHEREAS, the top-seeded St. Thomas More High School Lady Cougars defeated
6	the Central Lafourche High School Lady Trojans by a score of 1-0 to claim the state title on
7	February 22, 2018, at the Ragin' Cajun Soccer Facility, in Lafayette, Louisiana; and
8	WHEREAS, junior Peyton St. Pierre crossed a ball into the box in the fifteenth
9	minute and Mattie Marks took advantage of a misplay by the Lady Trojans' goal keeper to
10	head the ball into the bottom right corner to give the Lady Cougars a decisive 1-0 advantage;

12	WHEREAS, Mattie Marks was named Most Outstanding Player in the title game;

14	WHEREAS, in the first half, the Lady Cougars outshot the Lady Trojans 7-2 and had
15	three more scoring chances; and

18	up a goal through the previous playoff games remained stingy, especially sophomore Paityn
