Abstract: Increases the maximum per diem for commissioners of waterworks districts located in Jefferson Davis Parish and requires a two-thirds vote of the parish governing authority to increase the per diem for waterworks commissioners in the parish.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes parishes to create waterworks districts, which have control of water systems in their respective districts. Provides for meetings of the board of commissioners of any such district.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes a per diem of up to \$60 for waterworks district commissioners for attendance at meetings for up to 24 regular meetings and 12 special meetings each year.

<u>Present law</u> provides for \$100 as the maximum per diem for the commissioners of Jefferson Davis Parish Water District #4 and the Jefferson Davis Central Waterworks District.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases to \$150 the maximum per diem for the commissioners of any waterworks district located in Jefferson Davis Parish.

<u>Proposed law</u>, applicable to all Jefferson Davis Parish waterworks districts, provides that a per diem increase requires a 2/3rds vote of the parish governing authority after a public hearing that has been advertised twice in an official journal of the district.
