Barrow

<u>Present law</u> provides that certain information regarding child welfare shall not be released to applicants, recipients, or outside sources. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides for exceptions to allow certain information to be released when a former foster child or his legal tutor consent. <u>Proposed law</u> adds a provider of treatment or services, or one who is reviewing past services, as a party authorized to receive information from a case record.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides for the release of certain information for the purpose of education and training of foster youth and former foster youth, to the extent allowed by federal law, but prohibits the release of information that includes the identity of the birth parents or birth siblings or any information regarding the identity of the reporter in the case of abuse or neglect.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
