Abstract: Provides that rules and regulations relative to water system testing shall not apply to certain businesses which apply for or hold retail food establishment permits.

Present law provides that in order to protect the public health, the state health officer shall promulgate rules and regulations relative to retail food establishments.

Proposed law stipulates that the rules and regulations promulgated in accordance with present law shall not apply to a retail food establishment which is open to the public for fewer than 180 days per year and has a water system with fewer than 15 service connections.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to the original bill:

1. Revise proposed law to provide that the rules and regulations required by present law relative to regulation of retail food establishments shall not apply to a retail food establishment which is open to the public for fewer than 180 days per year and has a water system with fewer than 15 service connections.
