Abstract: Provides that rules and regulations relative to water system testing shall not apply to certain businesses which apply for or hold retail food establishment permits.

<u>Present law</u> provides that in order to protect the public health, the state health officer shall promulgate rules and regulations relative to retail food establishments.

<u>Proposed law</u> stipulates that the rules and regulations promulgated in accordance with <u>present law</u> shall not apply to a retail food establishment which is open to the public for fewer than 180 days per year and has a water system with fewer than 15 service connections.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Health and Welfare</u> to the original bill:

1. Revise <u>proposed law</u> to provide that the rules and regulations required by <u>present law</u> relative to regulation of retail food establishments shall not apply to a retail food establishment which is open to the public for fewer than 180 days per year and has a water system with fewer than 15 service connections.
