On page 1, line 2, after "reenact" delete the remainder of the line and insert in lieu thereof "R.S. 22:1880(C)(introductory paragraph) and (1), to enact R.S. 22:1880.1, and to repeal R.S. 22:1880(C)(4), relative to"

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, line 4, delete "list of out-of-network providers to a patient; to require"

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 1, line 6, delete "information on the facility's website" and insert in lieu thereof "potential facility charges"

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 1, line 9, change "R.S. 22:1880(C) and (E)" to "R.S. 22:1880(C)(introductory paragraph) and (1)"

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 1, at the beginning of line 10, change "22:1880(F)" to "22:1880.1"

AMENDMENT NO. 6

On page 1, line 13, after "facility" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 14 through 19 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

"shall do all of the following:

(1) ~~Provide a written notice to an enrollee or insured at the first registration contact with the enrollee or insured at the healthcare facility regarding nonemergency services. A copy of the written notice shall be signed by the enrollee or insured and be maintained by the healthcare facility. The written notice shall regarding nonemergency services to a patient whenever a healthcare facility provides a notice of privacy practices pursuant to 45 CFR. 164.520 to a patient for whom the healthcare facility has knowledge that a contract with a health insurance issuer is effective or upon the request of the patient. The written notice shall be signed by the patient and disclose all of the following items:~~

AMENDMENT NO. 7

Delete pages 2 through 5 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

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§1880.1. Provider-based entity disclosure

If a facility meets the definition of a provider-based entity, as defined by 42 CFR 413.65, and the facility is located off of the main hospital campus, the facility shall publicly post a notice to every patient disclosing the following:

1           (1) That the enrollee or insured is receiving services in a  
2 hospital-based outpatient facility where the facility provides the use of the  
3 facility, medical, or technical equipment, supplies, staff, and services.

4           (2) That depending on the enrollee's or insured's health insurance  
5 benefit plan and the actual services furnished by the facility, the patient may  
6 receive a facility charge billed separately from the physician that covers the  
7 fees for the use of the facility, medical, or technical equipment, supplies,  
8 staff, and services.

9           Section 2. R.S. 22:1880(C)(4) is hereby repealed in its entirety."
