SB 293 Engrossed

<u>Present law</u> provides relative to board membership and the powers and duties of the State Licensing Board for Contractors (board).

<u>Present law</u> adds two members to the 15 member board. One of the members shall be from the public at large who does not earn his livelihood in a construction-related industry, and the other member shall be appointed from the NAACP.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that beginning on July 1, 2018, and each quarter thereafter, the board shall submit to the presiding officer of each house of the legislature, by electronic or other means, a report that contains the following information for the previous quarter:

- (1) A list of licensees whose license has been suspended or revoked.
- (2) A list of any licensees whose license was reinstated.

Effective August 1, 2018.
