2 On page 1, delete line 2 and insert the following:

3 "To amend and reenact R.S. 11:710(A)(3), (4), and (6)(a) and (F)(3) and to enact
4 R.S. 11:710(A)(5)(e), relative to the reemployment"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, line 4, after "reemployment of" and before "interpreters" insert "pre-kindergarten
7 teachers,"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, line 5, after "of the" change "hearing impaired" to "deaf or hard of hearing"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 1, line 5, after "positions;" and before "and to" insert "to authorize the
12 reemployment of those in clerical office positions, subject to an earnings limitation; to
13 authorize all members to return to work without earnings limitation five years after
14 retirement;"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 5

16 On page 1, line 11, after "Section 1." delete the remainder of the line and insert "R.S.
17 11:710(A)(3), (4), and (6)(a) and (F)(3) are hereby amended and reenacted and R.S.
18 11:710(A)(5)(e) is hereby enacted to read as"

19 AMENDMENT NO. 6

20 On page 2, delete line 6 and insert the following:

21 "(a) A position for a full-time or part-time classroom teacher who teaches
22 any student in ~~kindergarten~~ pre-kindergarten through twelfth grade in a school where
23 a critical shortage exists."

24 AMENDMENT NO. 7

25 On page 2, line 10, at the beginning of the line change "hearing impaired" to "deaf or hard
26 of hearing"

27 AMENDMENT NO. 8

28 On page 2, delete line 13 and insert the following:

29 "(5) "Reemployment-eligible position" means any of the following:

31 (e) A position for clerical office personnel in an elementary or secondary
