WEAPONS/FIREARMS OR INCREASE GF EX See Note Creates the crime of illegally purchasing or selling a firearm

<u>Proposed law</u> creates the crime of illegally purchasing or selling a firearm by a licensed firearms dealer without waiting a mandatory 10-day period from purchase to delivery. Proposed law provides for criminal penalties and certain exceptions.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> will likely result in an indeterminable increase in SGF expenditures in the Department of Public Safety and Corrections - Correction Services if a person is convicted of illegally purchasing or selling a firearm without waiting a mandatory 10-day period from purchase to delivery. The maximum imprisonment term is 5 years, with or without hard labor.

SGF expenditures will increase by \$54.21 per offender per day if an offender is housed in a state facility or \$24.39 for a state offender housed in a local facility. An offender sentenced to the custody of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections - Correction Services for one year would increase SGF expenditures by \$19,786.65 (\$54.21 per day x 365 days) if housed in a state facility and \$8,902.35 (\$24.39 per day x 365 days) if housed in a local facility. Approximately 50% of state offenders are housed in state facilities and approximately 50% of state offenders are housed in local facilities.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> will likely result in an indeterminable increase in local funds revenue as a result of potential fines if a person convicted of illegally purchasing or selling a firearm without waiting a mandatory 10-day period from purchase to delivery. The maximum fine assessed is \$5,000. The potential revenue will accrue to the local governing authority.
