

1 WHEREAS, local governmental subdivisions across the state have different entities
2 charged with the enforcement of animal-related ordinances and various levels of funding
3 dedicated to enforcement of the ordinances; and

4 WHEREAS, local governments are best equipped to determine the needs and
5 limitations of their communities as it relates to the protection of animals.

6 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
7 urge and request local governmental subdivisions to adopt ordinances to provide definitions
8 for what constitutes proper shelters for animals and provide for penalties for leaving animals
9 outside without proper shelter.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted
11 to the Louisiana Municipal Association and the Police Jury Association of Louisiana.
