HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 45

SCHOOLS: Creates the Louisiana Commission on Safe Schools

1	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION
2	To create the Louisiana Commission on Safe Schools to study and review current laws,
3	policies, procedures, and programs in Louisiana relative to preparing for and
4	responding to threats and occurrences of school violence and to identify best
5	practices, programs, and initiatives to ensure stable and safe learning environments
6	for all students and school employees, and to report its findings and
7	recommendations to the governor, the legislature, and the State Board of Elementary
8	and Secondary Education by not later than March 1, 2019.
9	WHEREAS, the legislature recognizes and acknowledges that the safety and well-
10	being of all students is of the highest importance; and
11	WHEREAS, currently, there are laws in place in Louisiana relative to crime
12	prevention in schools, the implementation of crisis management and response plans for
13	schools, and training programs for school security guards and school resource officers; and
14	WHEREAS, all agree that schools should be safe and secure places for all students,
15	teachers, and staff members because without a safe learning environment, teachers cannot
16	teach and students cannot learn; and
17	WHEREAS, all students have the right to attend schools that provide safe, secure,
18	and orderly learning environments that foster academic achievement and that enable students
19	to go to school without fearing for their safety or the safety of their classmates and teachers;

WHEREAS, a review of current policies, procedures, programs, and laws relative 2 to providing safe and productive learning environments for all children is necessary to 3 ensure this right; and

4 WHEREAS, today, more than ever before, with recent incidents of school violence 5 and heightened awareness levels among the public occurring as a result of such incidents, 6 it is essential that education policymakers, lawmakers, law enforcement agencies, public 7 safety and emergency preparedness officials, parents, and others study and review current 8 laws, policies, procedures, and programs and identify best practices, programs, and 9 initiatives in order to ensure that all students and school employees are provided a stable and 10 secure learning environment in which they feel safe and protected.

11 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby 12 create the Louisiana Commission on Safe Schools, hereinafter referred to as the 13 "commission", to study and review current laws, policies, procedures, and programs in place 14 in Louisiana relative to preparing for and responding to threats and occurrences of school 15 violence; to identify best practices, programs, and initiatives to ensure stable and safe 16 learning environments for all students and school employees; and to report its findings and 17 recommendations to the governor, the legislature, and the State Board of Elementary and 18 Secondary Education by not later than March 1, 2019.

- 19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the commission shall consist of the following 20 members:

 - (1) The governor, or his designee.
- 22 (2) The speaker of the House of Representatives, or his designee.
- 23 (3) The president of the Senate, or his designee.
- 24 (4) The state superintendent of education, or his designee.
- 25 (5) The deputy secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, public 26 safety services, or his designee.
- 27 (6) The director of the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency 28 Preparedness, or his designee.
- 29 (7) The assistant secretary of the Louisiana Department of Health, office of 30 behavioral health, or his designee.

1	(8) The executive director, or his designee, of each of the following groups or
2	organizations:
3	(a) The Louisiana Association of Educators.
4	(b) The Louisiana Federation of Teachers.
5	(c) The Associated Professional Educators of Louisiana.
6	(d) The Louisiana Association of Principals.
7	(e) The Louisiana School Boards Association.
8	(f) The Louisiana Association of Public Charter Schools.
9	(g) The Nonpublic School Commission.
10	(h) The Louisiana Association of School Superintendents.
11	(i) The Louisiana Association of Chiefs of Police.
12	(j) The Louisiana Sheriffs' Association.
13	(k) The Louisiana Juvenile Judges Association.
14	(9) The president of the Louisiana Parent Teacher Association, or his designee.
15	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the commission's duties shall include but not be
16	limited to the following:
17	(1) To review current laws, policies, procedures, and programs in place in Louisiana
18	relative to school crisis management and response plans, school security measures, use of
19	school resource officers and other security personnel, response to threats of violence on
20	school campuses, and the authorization of persons to carry firearms on school campuses.
21	(2) To identify existing resources to address the needs of students who are in need
22	of behavioral health supports.
23	(3) To identify best practices, programs, and initiatives in all of these areas across
24	public schools in Louisiana and throughout the United States.
25	(4) To offer recommendations necessary to support the needs of students and school
26	employees in mitigating and responding to threats and occurrences of school violence.
27	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the members of the commission shall serve
28	without compensation but may receive reimbursement of expenses from his employer.

1 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the state superintendent of education shall 2 convene the commission for its first meeting not later than September 1, 2018, and shall 3 designate staff to assist the commission in performing its duties and responsibilities. 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the commission shall meet at least once each 5 quarter to review its progress and to make any recommendations it deems necessary and 6 shall annually elect a chairman and vice chairman. 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the commission shall terminate on January 13, 8 2020. 9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution shall be transmitted 10 to the governor, the speaker of the House of Representatives, the president of the Senate, and 11 the state superintendent of education who shall be responsible for disseminating a copy to 12 each group, organization, and office from which members of the commission are 13 designated.
