4	WHEREAS, Annie Carr graduated from Southern University in Baton Rouge,
5	Louisiana, with a bachelor of science degree in food and nutrition before entering her
6	dietetic internship program at Indiana University Medical Center in Indianapolis, Indiana,
7	for six months; and
8	WHEREAS, following completion of her internship she entered graduate school at
9	Indiana University/Purdue University at Indianapolis where she earned a master of education
10	degree and became a registered dietitian; and
11	WHEREAS, her professional career began at the Marion County Health and
12	Hospitals Corporation as a public health nutritionist for well baby clinics while still a
13	graduate student; when a new federally funded program for high risk women and children
14	called the Maternal and Infant Care Project was implemented in Marion County, she was
15	selected as the public health nutritionist; and
16	WHEREAS, she later accepted a job at the Indiana Department of Public Instruction
17	as the administrator of the Child Care Food Program and the Summer Food Service
18	Programs, and she later became the nutrition educator at the Division of Food and Nutrition
