Designates La. Hwy. 352 (Henderson Hwy.) as the "Pat Huval Memorial Highway".

Designates the Old Abbeville Bridge crossing the Vermilion River on La. Hwy. 14 East (Port St.) between La. Hwy. 335 (South Henry St.) and Main St. in Abbeville, La. as the "Vermilion Parish Veterans Memorial Bridge".

Directs Dept. of Transportation and Development to erect and maintain signs of these designations provided local or private monies are received by the department equal to the department's actual costs for material, fabrication, mounting posts, and installation of each sign, not to exceed \$550 per sign.

Directs the Dept. of Transportation and Development to include a dedication, in letters large enough to be readily observable by the public, on the signs erected and maintained to designate the Vermilion Parish Veterans Memorial Bridge that states "TO THOSE WHO DIED THAT LIBERTY MIGHT LIVE".

Effective August 1, 2018.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Transportation, Highways and Public Works to the engrossed bill:

1. Make technical changes.
2. Designate the Old Abbeville Bridge crossing the Vermilion River on La. Hwy. 14 East (Port St.) in Abbeville, La. as the "Vermilion Parish Veterans Memorial Bridge".
3. Direct the Dept. of Transportation and Development to add a dedication to the sign erected reflecting the Vermilion Parish Veterans Memorial Bridge designation that displays "TO THOSE WHO DIED THAT LIBERTY MIGHT LIVE".
