| 7 | WHEREAS, current law requires the Board of Regents to develop and maintain a |
| 8 | comprehensive state student financial aid plan that supports the Master Plan for Public |

| 10 | WHEREAS, in developing the state student financial aid plan, the board is to |
| 11 | consider all sources of financial aid available to students to attend postsecondary education |
| 12 | and the financial needs of such students; and |
| 13 | WHEREAS, student financial aid includes federal, state, and institutional aid that is |
| 14 | provided in the form of grants, loans, work-study program, tuition and fee waivers, and |
| 15 | scholarships; and |
| 16 | WHEREAS, the Senate Committee on Education and the House Committee on |
| 17 | Education are to review and approve the state student financial aid plan; and |
| 18 | WHEREAS, the Board of Regents has not updated the state student financial aid plan |

WHEREAS, half of Louisiana's working-age adults have a high school diploma or
less, and are lacking the skills and education needed to fully participate in the economy; and
WHEREAS, financial barriers prevent many working-age adults from pursuing
training and postsecondary education; and
WHEREAS, a comprehensive state student financial aid plan that includes a

component for working-age adults who are underemployed or unemployed could provide
greater access to postsecondary education and help fill voids in state workforce demands.

9 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate of the Legislature of Louisiana 10 does hereby urge and request the Board of Regents, in consultation with the postsecondary 11 education management boards, to update the comprehensive state student financial aid plan 12 in order to better meet the needs of all prospective Louisiana postsecondary education 13 students, both traditional and non-traditional, and better link students with careers demanded 14 by Louisiana's economy.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the commissioner of higher education, the president of the Louisiana Community and Technical College System, the president of the Louisiana State University and Agricultural and Mechanical College System, the president of the Southern University and Agricultural and Mechanical College System, and the president of the University of Louisiana System.
