SPECIAL DAY/WEEK/MONTH: Designates April 18, 2018, as AARP Louisiana Caregiver Day at the state capitol

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To designate Wednesday, April 18, 2018, as AARP Louisiana Caregiver Day at the state
3 capitol.

4 WHEREAS, Louisiana ranks thirty-seventh in the nation in long-term care; and

5 WHEREAS, an estimated six hundred sixty thousand family caregivers in Louisiana
6 provide care to adult relatives or friends, with the economic value of this care estimated to
7 be roughly six billion four hundred seventy million dollars annually; and

8 WHEREAS, almost ninety percent of Louisiana registered voters age forty-five and
9 older wish to remain in their homes and communities as they age; and

10 WHEREAS 28,000 older Louisianans are on waiting lists to receive assistance with
11 activities of daily living in their homes to avoid being put into nursing homes.

12 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
13 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby declare Wednesday, April 18, 2018, as AARP
14 Louisiana Caregiver Day at the state capitol.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a suitable copy of this Resolution be transmitted
16 to Andrew Muhl, Director of Advocacy at AARP Louisiana.
