2 national security programs for two years; and

3 WHEREAS, in 2010, Mr. Turner returned to FBI Headquarters as deputy assistant
4 director of the information technology engineering division; from 2012 to 2014, Mr. Turner
5 served as the special agent in charge of the Louisville, Kentucky, field office; he has served
6 as special agent in charge of the FBI field office in Houston, Texas, since 2014; and

7 WHEREAS, as special agent in charge, Mr. Turner also serves as the south-central
8 region domestic representative of national intelligence; he meets quarterly with other FBI
9 special agents in charge; senior executives from the U.S. intelligence community; and
10 federal, state, and local law enforcement intelligence personnel to enhance collaboration and
11 develop strategies to mitigate emerging threats and risks related to national security; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Turner is a recipient of the 2014 Presidential Rank Award, which
13 is awarded to the top one percent of senior executives in the U.S. government; he is
14 recognized as a transformational leader and visionary; and

15 WHEREAS, Perrye K. Turner merits the highest commendation and sincere
16 congratulations for his contributions to the health and safety of his fellow citizens.

17 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the
18 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Perrye K. Turner for serving as special agent
19 in charge of the FBI field office in Houston, Texas; does hereby recognize his exemplary
20 service to his community, state, and nation during his nearly thirty years in federal law
21 enforcement; and does hereby extend to him full measures of continued success and
22 happiness in all of his future endeavors.
