HOUSE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Representative Smith to Engrossed House Bill No. 265 by Representative Smith

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, at the end of line 17, delete the period "." and insert the following:

3 "if the person submits documentation to the registrar of voters from the appropriate
4 correction official showing that the person has not been incarcerated pursuant to the
5 order within the last five years."

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 2, after line 26, insert the following:

8 "Section 2. Prior to the effective date of this Act, the secretary of state shall
9 work with the Department of Public Safety and Corrections to develop a form or
10 forms to allow a person who is or was under an order of imprisonment for conviction
11 of a felony to meet the requirements of R.S. 18:102(A)(1) and 177(A) as amended
12 by this Act.

13 Section 3. This Act shall become effective on March 1, 2019."
