Amendments proposed by House Committee on Health and Welfare to Original House Bill
No. 826 by Representative Hunter

1 AMENDMENT NO. 12 On page 1, line 6, after "authorized;" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 7 in its
3 entirety and insert in lieu thereof "and to"4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 19, after "use" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 20

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 2, at the beginning of line 1, delete "than ten licensees"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 2, delete lines 4 through 15 in their entirety and insert in lieu thereof the following:

10 "(2) No person shall be eligible for a specialty license provided for in this
11 Subsection unless he is a pharmacist licensed by the board.12 (3) The board shall establish financial stability requirements for each entity
13 awarded a license pursuant to this Subsection. At minimum, such requirements shall
14 include depositing into an escrow account, within ninety days of the award of the
15 license, a minimum amount as surety.16 (4) The board shall report to the House and Senate committees on health and
17 welfare annually all of the following information:18 (a) The total number of applications for licenses provided for in this
19 Subsection.20 (b) The number of applications for licenses provided for in this Subsection
21 approved by the board.22 (c) The number of applications for licenses provided for in this Subsection
23 denied by the board.24 (d) Demographic information concerning applicants including but not
25 limited to age and race.26 (5) No person who holds a license issued in accordance with this Subsection
27 on the effective date of this Paragraph shall be eligible for renewal of that license
28 unless the majority stake of the marijuana dispensing pharmacy that he operates is
29 owned by a Louisiana-licensed pharmacist."
