2	To enact R.S. 22:1056, relative to health insurance policy coverage of incarcerated persons
3	prior to adjudication; to require insurance coverage for health care provided
4	premiums are paid; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 22:1056 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	§1056. Health insurance coverage for incarcerated individuals
8	A. Beginning January 1, 2019, every hospital, health, or medical expense
9	insurance policy, hospital or medical service contract, employee welfare benefit
10	plan, health and accident insurance policy, every policy of group, family group,
11	blanket, or association health and accident insurance, and every self-insurance
12	plan, health maintenance organization plan, and preferred provider
13	organization plan, except for the Office of Group Benefits, delivered or issued
14	for delivery in this state shall provide benefits for health care to the insured if
15	he is detained in a correctional facility and has not been adjudicated or
16	convicted of a criminal offense. Nothing herein shall alter any of the terms and
17	conditions of the applicable coverage which shall remain applicable to all such
18	services provided.
19	<b>B.</b> The provisions of this Section shall apply only if the detainee has valid
20	health care coverage in effect at the time medical treatment is received and any
21	premiums for such coverage are current.
22	C. The provisions of this Section shall apply to all existing hospital,
23	health, or medical expense insurance policies, hospital or medical service
24	contracts, employee welfare benefit plans, health and accident insurance
25	policies, policies of group, family group, blanket, or association health and
