8 On page 1, line 10, after "Except as" and before "Paragraphs" insert "modified by the
9 provisions of" and delete "provided in"

11 On page 1, delete lines 18 through 20 in their entirety and insert the following:

12 (d) Except as provided by Subparagraph (3)(c) of this Subsection, the court
13 may shall order that the offender not operate a motor vehicle during the period of
14 probation, or such shorter time as set by the court, unless any vehicle, while"

15 AMENDMENT NO. 5

16 On page 2, line 6, after "C." delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 7 through 25
17 in their entirety and insert a set of asterisks "* * *"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 6

19 On page 2, at the beginning of line 26, change "(3)" to "(2)" and delete "If" and insert
20 "When"

31 (b) On or after September 30, 2003, if the person submitted to the test and
32 the test results show a blood alcohol level of 0.08 percent or above by weight, his
33 driving privileges shall be suspended for ninety days from the date of suspension on

 2 ~~days,~~ and for three hundred sixty-five days from the date of suspension, ~~without~~
 3 ~~eligibility for a hardship license,~~ on second and subsequent violations occurring
 4 within ~~five~~ ten years of the first offense. If the person was under the age of twenty-
 5 one years on the date of the test and the test results show a blood alcohol level of
 6 0.02 percent or above by weight, his driving privileges shall be suspended for one
 7 hundred eighty days from the date of suspension.
