Amendments proposed by House Committee on Education to Original House Bill No. 399
by Representative Gary Carter

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 15, after "or" and before "reduce" delete "equitably"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, at the end of line 16, delete "by an" and at the beginning of line 17, delete "equal
5 percentage on a pro rata basis,"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 2, at the end of line 6, change "(3)" to "(2)"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 2, delete lines 8 through 24 and insert the following:

10 "(2) To the extent feasible:

11 (a) First, the award of each student who qualifies for an Honors
12 Award and whose pretax household family income is below the median
13 pretax household income in the state shall be fully funded.

14 (b) Second, the award of each student who qualifies for a
15 Performance Award and whose pretax household family income is below the
16 median pretax household income shall be fully funded.

17 (3) From any remaining available funds, the award of each student
18 who qualifies for an Opportunity Award or TOPS-Tech Award and whose
19 pretax household income is below the median pretax household income in
20 the state and the award of each student who qualifies for an Honors Award
21 or Performance Award and whose pretax household income is between the
22 median pretax household income in the state and one-and-a-half times the
23 pretax household income in the state at the eightieth percentile is partially
24 funded based on a sliding scale established by the administering agency that
25 takes into consideration academic performance and family income."
