 Provides relative to advanced practice registered nursing

Present law requires advanced practice registered nurses to practice in accordance with collaborative practice agreements with licensed physicians or dentists. Proposed law creates an exception to present law for advanced practice registered nurses practicing in a licensed hospital or nursing facility.

**EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

**REVENUE EXPLANATION**

Proposed law will decrease SGR collections for the LA State Board of Nursing (LSBN) by an estimated \$30,900 annually. The LSBN currently collects a \$50 fee associated with processing prescriptive authority change orders for advanced practice registered nurses (APRNs) that have entered into collaborative practice agreements with physicians. The LSBN reports processing 1,236 prescriptive authority change orders in FY 17.

The LSBN will realize a reduction in revenue as a result of processing fewer prescriptive authority change orders associated with collaborative practice agreements for APRNs practicing at hospitals or nursing facilities. This reduction is dependent upon the number of change orders processed in a given year, as well as if the APRN filing the prescriptive authority change order is practicing in a hospital or nursing facility. The LSBN anticipates a 50% reduction in change orders, which would result in a revenue loss of \$30,900 annually for the board to the extent the number of prescriptive authority change orders is consistent with historical levels (1,236 change orders \* 50% \* \$50).
