- 5 committed on or after January 1, 2019; to provide for submission of the
- 6 proposed amendment to the electors; and to provide for related matters."

7 AMENDMENT NO. 2

8 On page 1, delete lines 11 through 16 in their entirety and insert the following:

- 9 "Section 17.(A) Jury Trial in Criminal Cases. A criminal case in 10 which the punishment may be capital shall be tried before a jury of twelve persons, all of whom must concur to render a verdict. A case for an offense 11 committed prior to January 1, 2019, in which the punishment is 12 13 necessarily confinement at hard labor shall be tried before a jury of twelve persons, ten of whom must concur to render a verdict. A case for an offense 14 committed on or after January 1, 2019, in which the punishment is 15 necessarily confinement at hard labor shall be tried before a jury of 16 twelve persons, all of whom must concur to render a verdict.
