Abstract: Extends the amount of time a background check may be used in motions for expungement.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the expungement of criminal records and provides for the forms which shall be used to seek an expungement.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends the <u>present law</u> forms for a motion for expungement and a motion for interim expungement to extend from 30 days to 60 days the amount of time that a background check may be used in seeking an expungement. <u>Proposed law</u> also makes technical corrections to <u>present law</u> motion for expungement forms.

(Amends C.Cr.P. Arts. 989, 992, 993, and 994)
