10	principal is physically located in this state at the time of the remote
11	online notarization.
12	B. In performing an online notarial act, a notary public shall
13	verify the identity of the principal at the time that the signature of the
14	principal is taken by using communication technology that meets the
15	requirements of this Chapter and rules adopted under this Chapter.
16	Identity of the principal and witnesses appearing remotely may be
17	verified by the notary public's personal knowledge of the person creating
18	the electronic signature or by all of the following:
19	(1) Remote presentation by the principal of a government-issued
20	identification credential, including a passport or driver's license, that
21	contains the signature and a photograph of the principal.
22	(2) Credential analysis.
23	(3) Identity proofing.
24	C. A notary public performing an online notarial act shall take
25	reasonable steps to ensure that the communication technology used in
26	each online notarial act is secure from unauthorized interception.
27	D. The electronic notarial certificate for any online notarial act
28	shall state the physical locations of each principal and of each witness
29	and shall state that the notarial act is an online notarial act."

40	act.
41	§633. Acts involving Louisiana property
42	Any electronic notarial act or online notarial act affecting
43	property located in Louisiana is deemed to have occurred in Louisiana,
44	regardless of the location of the notary public, principal, or witnesses at
45	the time of the electronic notarial act or online notarial act, and such
46	acts shall be executed in accordance with the standards of this Chapter

and the rules promulgated in accordance with this Chapter. Any

1	electronic notarial act or online notarial act affecting property located
2	in Louisiana not executed in accordance with the standards of this
3	Chapter and the rules promulgated in accordance with this Chapter
4	shall be considered relatively null.
5	§634. Duplicate execution; counterparts
6	A. An act executed both by electronic means and by physical
7	signature, whether as duplicates or counterparts, are deemed to
8	constitute the same act.
9	B. A failure in technology causing a promissory note to be
10	executed both by electronic means and by physical act shall be deemed
11	to be the execution of one promissory note and shall not create an
12	obligation to pay the same sum under both notes.
13	C. A contract executed in part by electronic means and in part
14	by physical means shall constitute one act."
