KEYWORD AND SUMMARY AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

PUBLIC PROPERTY. Constitutional amendment to permit the donation of the use of public equipment and personnel to the state or a political subdivision. (2/3 - CA13s1)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Clarifies that the use or personnel is being used for an activity or function which the governmental body is authorized to exercise.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

<u>Present constitution</u> prohibits the loan, pledge, or donation of funds, credit, property, or things of value of the state. Provides an extensive list of exceptions to this prohibition.

<u>Proposed constitutional amendment</u> retains <u>present constitution</u> and adds an exception that, pursuant to written agreement, permits the use of public equipment and personnel by a political subdivision upon the request of another political subdivision for an activity or function which the requesting political subdivision is authorized to exercise.

Provides for submission of the proposed amendment to the voters at the statewide election to be held on November 6, 2018.
