15	or otherwise unnecessary book in the possession of the library to any hospital,
16	correctional facility, public or private institution, nonprofit organization, adult
17	education program, youth organization, school, or individual.
18	(b) The proceeds collected from the sale of library books pursuant to
19	Subparagraph (a) of this Paragraph shall be remitted to the Livingston Parish
20	Library Board of Control and shall be used exclusively for the maintenance,
21	operation, and support of the Livingston Parish Library.
