 Re-creates entities transferred to or placed within the office of the governor. (6/30/18)

Present law requires that 17 specified agencies shall begin to terminate their operations on July 1, 2018, and provides that all legislative authority for such entities shall cease as of July 1, 2019, unless legislation is enacted that authorizes the recreation of the agencies prior thereto.

Proposed law provides for recreation of 17 specified agencies, effective June 30, 2018, in accordance with the "Sunset" law; supersedes provisions of the "Sunset" law that sets out the procedure for review and recreation and requires a separate bill to recreate each statutory entity (allowing recreation as a group in a single legislative instrument); provides for a new termination date of July 1, 2022.
