- 10 AMENDMENT NO. 4
- 11 On page 2, line 3, delete "two individuals" and insert "one consumer"
- 12 AMENDMENT NO. 5
- On page 2, between lines 15 and 16, insert the following: 13
- 14 "(2)(a)The consumer member shall be selected from the state at large and 15 shall possess all of the following qualifications:
- (i) Is a citizen of the United States and has been a resident of Louisiana for 16 17 at least one year immediately prior to appointment.
- (ii) Has attained the age of majority. 18
- 19 (iii) Has never been licensed by any of the licensing boards identified in R.S.
- 36:259(A), nor shall he have a spouse who has ever been licensed by a board 20 21 identified in R.S. 36:259(A).
- 22 (iv) Has never been convicted of a felony.
- 23 (v) Does not have and has never had a material financial interest in the
- healthcare profession. 24
- (b) The consumer members shall be full voting members of the board with 25
- 26 all rights and privileges conferred on board members, except that the consumer
- 27 members shall not participate in the grading of individual examinations."
