DWI: Provides relative to costs assessed for violations of driving while intoxicated

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

- 1. Makes technical corrections.
- 2. Reduces the <u>proposed law</u> special costs assessed for convictions of operating a vehicle while intoxicated <u>from</u> \$150 to \$125.
- 3. Restores the <u>present law</u> costs paid to the governing authority who performed the analysis.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

<u>Present law</u> provides that a person convicted of a DWI violation who was subjected to a blood, breath, or urine analysis for alcohol or any controlled dangerous substance shall be assessed an additional \$75 as special costs to be paid as follows:

- (1) \$25 to the governing authority owning the instrument used to perform the analysis.
- (2) \$50 to the governing authority whose agency performed the analysis.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the special costs <u>from</u> \$75 <u>to</u> \$125, with \$75 paid to the governing authority owning the instrument and otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.
