HOUSE RESOLUTION NO. 186

BY REPRESENTATIVE BAGNERIS

HOUSE/RULES: Provides for a procedure to pass over controversial instruments on third reading, to be referred to as the "Bagneris Rule"

1 A RESOLUTION

2 To adopt House Rule 8.20.1 of the Rules of Order of the House of Representatives to
3 provide for a procedure to pass over controversial instruments on third reading.

4 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the Legislature of Louisiana
5 that House Rule 8.20.1 of the Rules of Order of the House of Representatives is hereby
6 adopted to read as follows:

7 Rule 8.20.1. Calendar; passing over certain instruments; "Bagneris Rule"

8 A. On any legislative day in the regular order upon third reading and final
9 consideration or final passage for any instrument, at the discretion of the Speaker and
10 upon the motion of any member, the House may pass over any instrument that any
11 member objects to as controversial under the provisions of this rule, which shall be
12 referred to as the "Bagneris Rule".

13 B. The motion to operate under the Bagneris Rule shall not be debatable and
14 shall require the favorable vote of a majority of the members present and voting.

15 C. Any instrument passed over under the Bagneris Rule shall remain on the
16 calendar in the same numerical order on the next legislative day.

Bagneris

Abstract: Provides that, in regular order on third reading and final consideration or final passage, the House may pass over any instrument that any member objects to as controversial and provides that any instrument passed over shall remain on the calendar in the same numerical order on the next legislative day (to be known as the "Bagneris Rule").

Present House Rules provide for the order of business and procedures and motions relative to returning legislative instruments to and calling legislative instruments from the calendar.

Proposed House Rule provides that on any legislative day in the regular order and upon third reading and final consideration or final passage for any instrument, at the discretion of the Speaker and upon the motion of any member, the House may pass over any instrument that any member objects to as controversial under the proposed House Rule, which shall be referred to as the "Bagneris Rule". Provides that the motion to operate under the Bagneris Rule is not debatable and requires the favorable vote of a majority of the members present and voting. Further provides that any instrument passed over remains on the calendar in the same numerical order on the next legislative day.
