KEYWORD AND SUMMARY AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

MOTOR VEHICLES. Provides for special prestige license plates for "Upside Downs" and for certain license plates to bear the international symbol of accessibility. (1/1/19)

SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL

1. Adds provisions creating the "Upside Down" special prestige license plate and collection of an annual royalty fee of \$25.
2. Requires that the DPS&C collect the royalty fee and forward it to Upside Down, Inc.

DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE

Present law requires that special prestige license plates issued in accordance with R.S. 47:463.6 et seq. contain the uniform alpha-numeric series accompanied by a symbol or emblem representing the organization requesting such plate.

Proposed law requires, on and after January 1, 2019, that any available special prestige license plate may additionally bear the international symbol of accessibility, upon request and if the applicant is eligible in accordance with the provisions of R.S. 47:463.4.

Proposed law creates the "Upside Down" special prestige license plate for use on passenger cars, pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, motorcycles, and vans. Requires collection of an annual royalty fee by the Department of Public Safety and Corrections (DPS&C) to be forwarded to Upside Down, Inc.

Effective January 1, 2019.

(Amends R.S. 47:463(A)(3)(a); adds R.S. 47:463.4.4 and 463.196)
