

HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS

SANITARY CODE: Provides relative to water system testing at certain businesses which apply for or hold retail food permits

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Deletes proposed law providing that the rules and regulations relative to retail food establishments required by present law shall not apply to a retail food establishment which is open to the public for fewer than 180 days per year and has a water system with fewer than 15 service connections.
2. Provides that present administrative code relative to retail food establishments shall not apply to a water supply that services a retail food establishment which does not meet the definition of "public water system" in present law.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law provides that in order to protect the public health, the state health officer shall promulgate rules and regulations relative to retail food establishments.

Proposed law provides that such regulations shall not apply to a water supply that services a retail food establishment which does not meet the definition of "public water system" in present law.
