## HB 139 2018 Regular Session Hoffmann

PUBLIC SERVICE COMN: Provides an exception with respect to certain telephonic solicitations during a declared state of emergency

## **Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

1. Makes a technical change.

<u>Present law</u> generally prohibits certain telephonic solicitations during a state of emergency as declared by the governor. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

 $\underline{\text{Present law}} \text{ defines "telephonic solicitation"}. \ \underline{\text{Proposed law}} \text{ retains } \underline{\text{present law}} \text{ and makes technical changes}.$ 

<u>Proposed law</u> expressly provides an exception to exclude "La.-based community blood centers with nonprofit status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code collecting voluntarily donated blood products for patient transfusion" from the provisions of <u>present</u> law.
