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ENVIRONMENT/WASTE TIRES RE +\$1,144,363 SD RV See Note Increases the waste tire disposal fee applicable to passenger and light truck tires

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the fees in present law on passenger/light truck tires <u>from</u> \$2 <u>to</u> \$2.25 through July 31, 2022. <u>Proposed law</u> provides that beginning August 1, 2022, the fee per passenger/light truck tires shall be \$2.

## **EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION**

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) anticipates additional payments of \$1,029,927 to processors for the proper disposal of collected waste tires to the authorized end use. Per LA R.S. 30:2418(I) DEQ pays processors 7.5 cents per pound.

## **REVENUE EXPLANATION**

There will be an increase in revenue to the statutorily dedicated Waste Tire Management Fund as a result of the fee increase for passenger/light truck tires. The proposed legislation raises the waste tire fee by \$0.25 for passenger/light truck tires through July 31, 2022.

The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has collected an average of \$9.15 M per year in passenger tire fees over the past five years based on the average sale of 4.6 M passenger tires annually. To the extent the average number of passenger tires purchased in future years remains consistent, DEQ expects to collect an additional \$1.1 M through FY 22, and have a minimal increase in revenues in FY 23 as a result of the sunset.
