Keyword and summary of the bill as proposed by the Conference Committee

HEALTH DEPARTMENT. Provides relative to death certificates. (8/1/18)

Report adopts House amendments to:

1. Require registration of death certificates using the Louisiana Electronic Event Registration System of the Louisiana Department of Health, state registrar of vital records.
2. Require registration to take effect on January 1, 2019.

Report amends the bill to:

1. Clarify that the coroner or physician is certifying the death certificate using the Louisiana Electronic Event Registration System.

Digest of the bill as proposed by the Conference Committee

Proposed law requires coroners and physicians who sign death certificates to certify the certificates using the Louisiana Electronic Event Registration System of the Louisiana Department of Health, state registrar of vital records.

Effective January 1, 2019.
