Amendments proposed by Representative Abramson to Reengrossed Senate Bill No. 408 by Senator Appel

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 5, between lines 28 and 29, insert the following:

3	"E.(1) No person shall leave a train, locomotive, or railroad car
4	unsecured, either for eighteen consecutive hours or at any time between the
5	hours of 8 pm and 6 am, within the jurisdiction of the railroad board in Orleans
6	Parish.
7	(2) For purposes of this Subsection, a train, locomotive, or railroad car
8	shall be considered unsecured if it is left in an area that is not enclosed within
9	a fence or other barrier with locked gates or doors to prevent unauthorized
10	entry and trespass into the area and is not either continuously occupied or
11	<u>observed in person by the owner, lessee, operator, or port and harbor police or</u>
12	<u>continuously observed through real time live video monitoring by the port and</u>
13	harbor police
14	(3) If the port and harbor police provide real time live video monitoring,
15	such monitoring shall cover the entirety of the outside of the train, locomotive,
16	or railroad car, including all cars and sides of cars, and shall include an in
17	person police response time within ten minutes of the location of such train,
18	locomotive, or railroad car.
19	(4)(a) The board shall be responsible for any violation of this Subsection
20	regardless of the offender. The board shall be fined not less than one hundred
21	dollars nor more than five hundred dollars for a violation of this Subsection.
22	(b) The provisions of this Subsection shall be enforced by the Louisiana
23	State Police."
24	AMENDMENT NO. 2

25 On page 15, after line 29, insert the following:

"Section 6. Notwithstanding the provisions of R.S. 24:175, the provisions of this Act
are nonseverable. It is intended that if any provisions of this Act, or the application thereof
to any person or circumstances is held invalid under the Constitution of Louisiana or of the
United States by a final and nonappealable judgment, then such provision's ineffectiveness
or invalidity will invalidate this Act."
